Thank you to all those parents who attended the Mental Health Focus coffee morning. We will send some of the materials on Parent hub in the coming weeks.



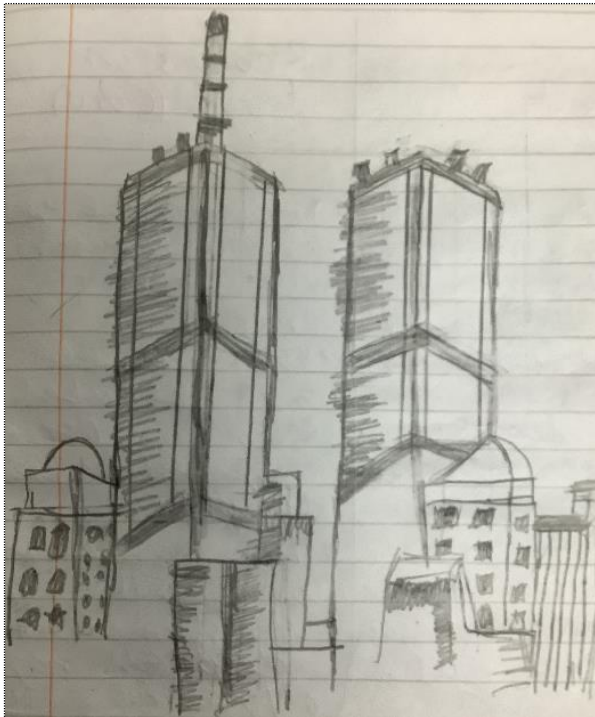
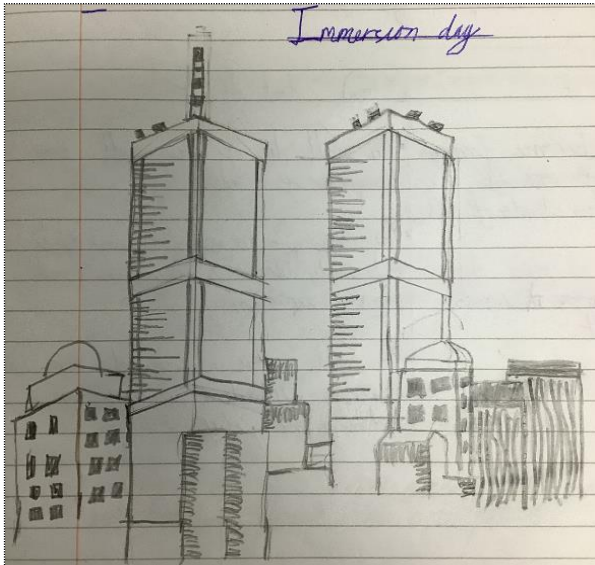
School Inclusion Support Officer
