Learning in Cedar Class

In Cedar Class this term we have been having discussions around our senses and how important they are to us. In English, we have been focusing on a book about a girl called Cinnamon who has beautiful eyes made of pearls but who cannot see. On Immersion Day, we role played what it would be like if we couldn't see. We had to decide what different objects were by using our other senses of touch, hearing, smelling and tasting to help us. Some children said it was difficult because they were so used to seeing that they would find it difficult if they lost their sight and they would require a lot of help. We also used our sense of hearing in PE and RE to help us tune into sounds and how they make us feel. So far, children have said they are thankful for the five senses they have and they are beginning to understand how each one is important and how they all rely on each other to help them to get everyday tasks done.
