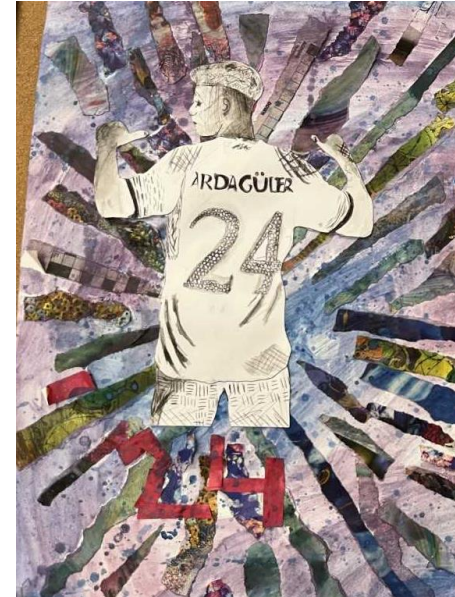


Learning in Oak Class

Oak Class are firmly in the midst of their SATs preparation now. They are working hard to close gaps in their learning and they are really benefitting from so much repeated practice. We are delighted with the progress they are making, especially in Arithmetic. This week we have been working a lot on BODMAS questions and on problems involving the multiplication of decimal numbers.

Our big comprehension focus has been on how to use evidence from a text to support a point that we want to make. The ability to select evidence is so important. Parents often ask us teachers what kind of questions they can ask their children when they are hearing them read - a brilliant way of questioning your child is: "Can you find me the sentence in this paragraph that shows ... ?" For example, "Can you find me the sentence in this paragraph that shows the boy is upset?" This skill helps the children so much when they get to Upper Key Stage 2 and are being asked questions such as, "What impression do you get of ... ? Find evidence from the text to support your answer."

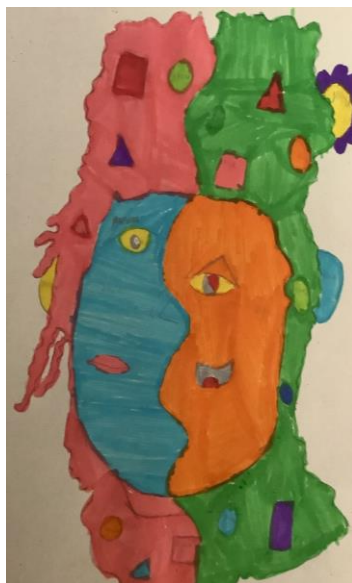
