## Learning in Sycamore Class

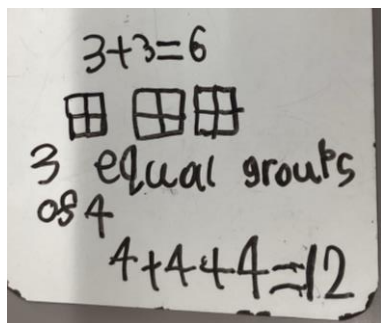
