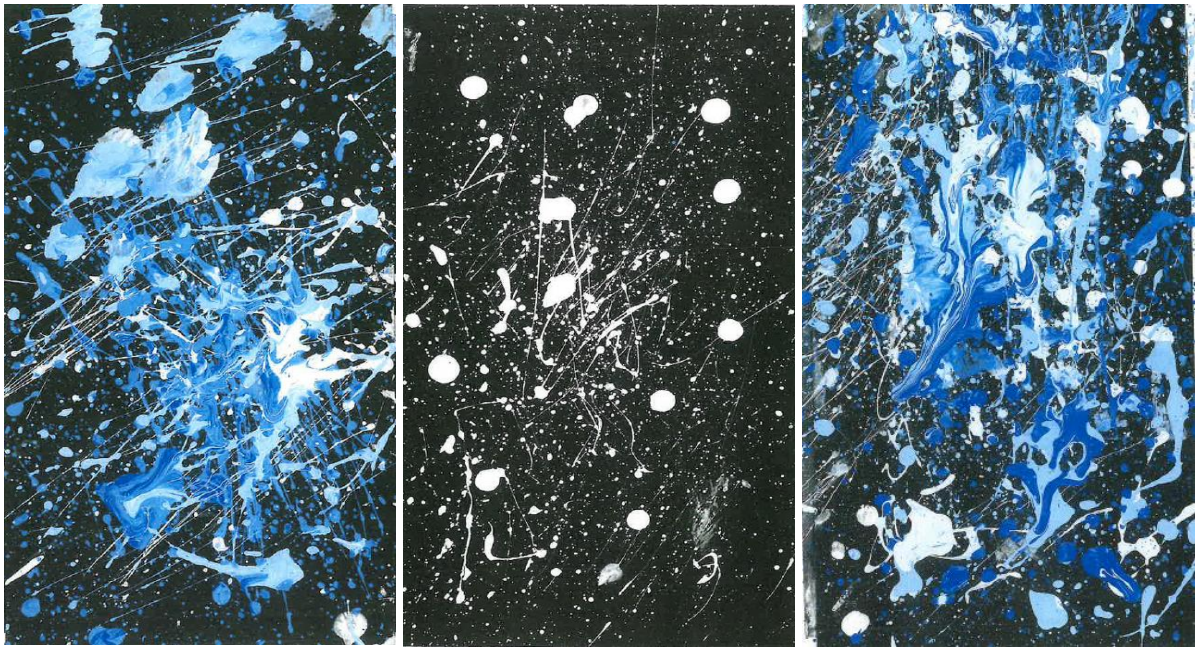
EYFS Christmas Stay and Play
