XLP Bus Visits Christ Church

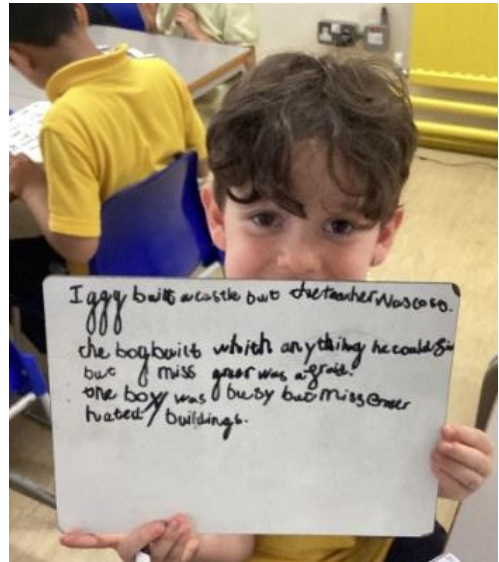
