I really enjoyed Sandra's visit with her coloured cards and orange trolley. All of the books looked exciting and reading is definitely becoming one of my favourite things to do!

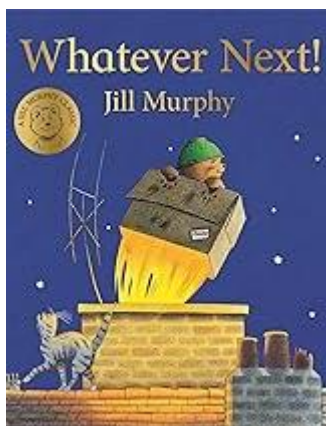
