New Government Attendance Rules

No Holidays will be authorised in term time -

Under Section 444(1) of the Education Act 1996 Attendance and Children Out of School may issue a penalty notice(s). Notices are issued per parent per child,

If you are issued with a penalty notice you will be fined £80, to be paid within 21 days. If payment is made after 21 days, but within 28 days, the fine rises to £160. If you are issued a second fine the charge will be £160 from day 1. The fine is payable by each parent for each child. Alternatively, the Authority may decide to prosecute you without first issuing a fine. You may also be prosecuted if you have had two penalty notices for the same child in the last three years. The three years will begin with the date of the first penalty notice issued.

Please note that this is a nationwide, central Government policy that Christ Church is required to follow by law.
