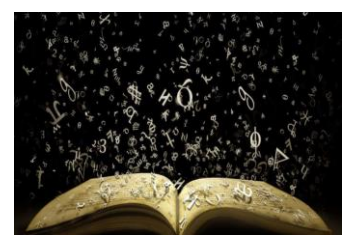

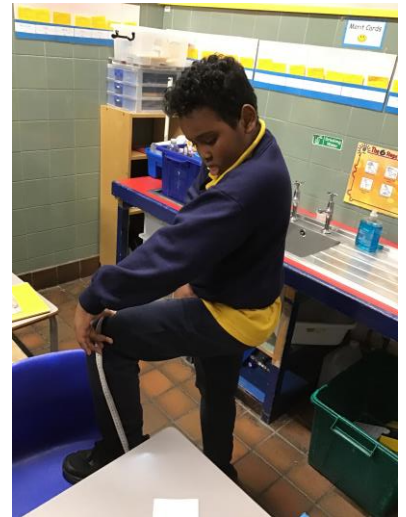
Visits from The Crick Institute



This week, we were thrilled to welcome The Francis Crick Institute for a series of exciting science workshops with all classes from Year 1 to Year 6. The children had a fantastic time taking part in fun, hands-on activities that brought science to life in a creative and engaging way.



Year 3 had a fantastic visit from Andy at The Francis Crick Institute, who came to teach them all about the human body. The children were fascinated to learn that the femur is the longest bone in the body and that the spine is actually made up of 33 different parts. Everyone had a go at measuring their own femur bone using a tape measure, which sparked lots of excitement and curiosity. One of the highlights of the session was using feely bags - students had to feel and guess the mystery objects inside, helping them to think like real scientists.

Dear Jaida-Summer,

Thank you for writing to the Government about changes that you would like to make at your school, Christ Church C of E Primary. I am impressed that you are already thinking about what you want to do differently and why, and that you have taken the time to write a really good letter.

Although the changes that you would like are for your school leadership team to decide on, it's really helpful for me to know what matters to young people like you. I want to make sure that my Government gives young people a good deal, and I feel strongly that they should have a voice in the national conversation. That's why I could like the voting age to be lowered from 18 to 16 years old. In just a few years' time you and your classmates will be able to have your say on who runs the country.

In the mean time, there are lots of other ways to help make sure that your voice is heard. I hope that you will make sure to complete your school's Pupil Voice Survey, and think about standing for your School Council, so that you can take your priorities to the school leadership team. When you are a little older, as well as being a student voice in your school, you might want to think about joining the Camden Youth Council, or even stand to be a Camden Youth MP.

And please remember that change often takes time. You have started young, and that is great. I hope that you will keep aiming high and making the case for what you believe in!

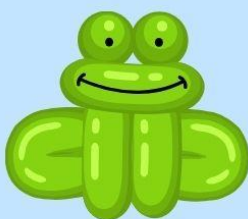

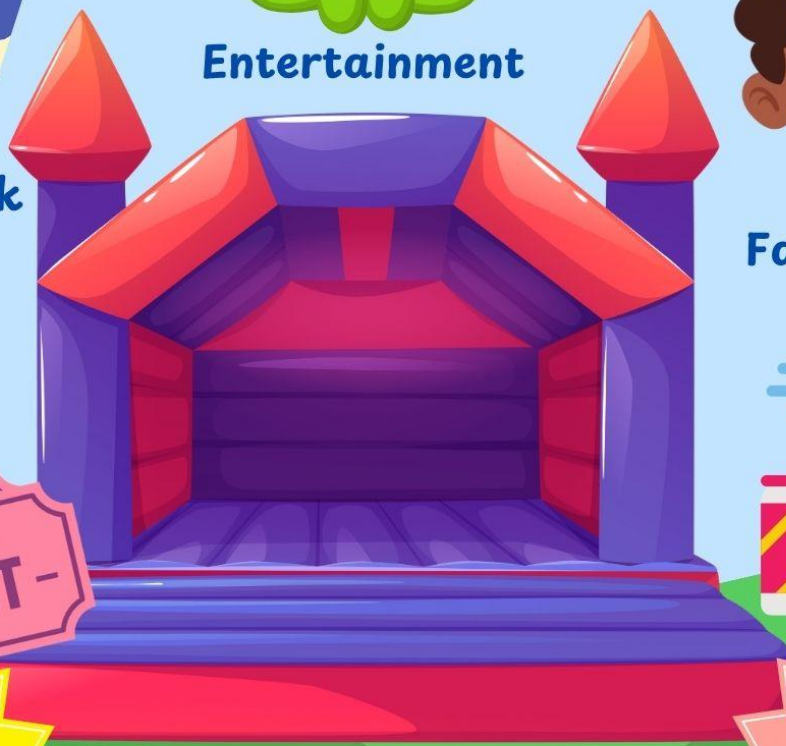
