







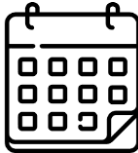

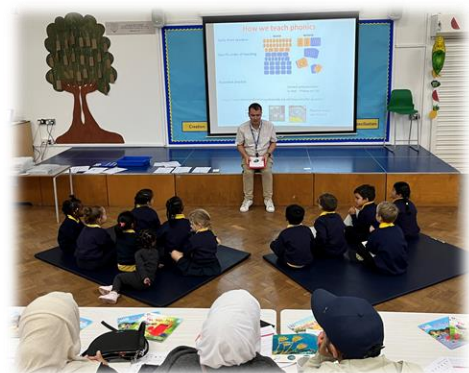


Secondary Transfer Forms

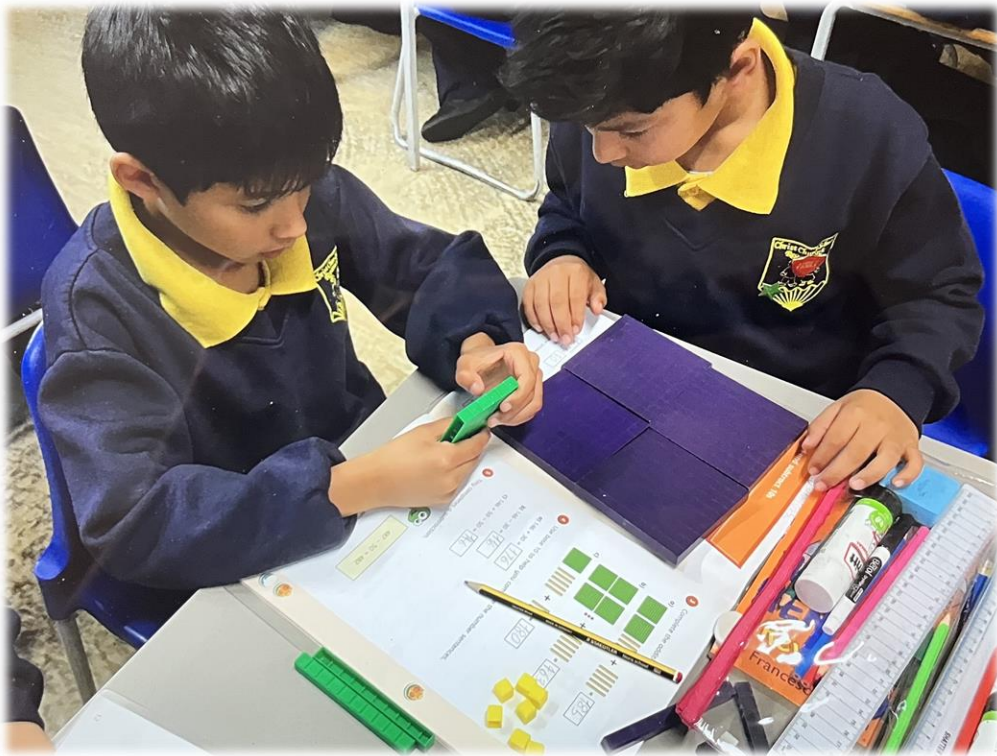
