Please send any harvest donations in to the school office next week. Merits are being given to all children who bring in a donation.

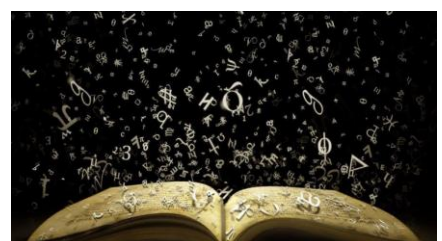

Willow Class Visit John Keats House

We asked Year 5 what they got up to at John Keats House last week. This is what they told us:

We talked about John Keats' early life in medicine and looked at some of the equipment he used. There was a beautiful jar that was used to keep leeches in for blood-letting.

We enjoyed seeing and hearing about the history of surgeries and how they were carried out. Also, we were fascinated with the concept that there was no anaesthetic or medication around to help numb pain.

Then, we spent time in John's study room and got a feel of the pen he used to write his poems with (an ostrich feather dipped in ink). The sound of scribbling was played in the room to echo writing with the pen on paper.

We then went upstairs to the room assigned to his girlfriend, Fanny, and we were told about their secret engagement - because he was just starting in his poetry writing, he had to keep their relationship a secret. We saw some pictures of her and had a look in her book of dresses.

After that, we went into the front room of the house, which was the room John shared with many friends and family. He had a chair he would often lie in, especially when he was sick. The chair was positioned right in front of some double doors leading out to a small veranda.

This room also had a grandfather clock that was there from the beginning (200 or more years ago). It got to witness parties, family gatherings and many meetings.
