## Online Safety Tip of the Week

### TikTok and Online Safety

TikTok is a popular app where children and young people can watch and share short videos. While it can be entertaining and creative, it is important for parents to be aware that some content may not always be suitable for younger users and children may interact with people they do not know online. TikTok officially requires users to be at least 13 years old to create an account. It is rated 12+ on the Apple App Store and listed for "Teens" or "Parental Guidance" on the Google Play Store.



Talk to your child about how they use TikTok and only explore the app together. Check privacy settings to ensure accounts are set to private, review who can comment or send messages, and consider using the Family Pairing feature to help manage screen time and content settings.

Remind children never to share personal information such as their school, location or phone number online. Encourage them to tell a safe adult if they see anything upsetting or if someone online makes them feel uncomfortable. Regular conversations and taking an interest in what children are watching online can help keep them safe and supported.

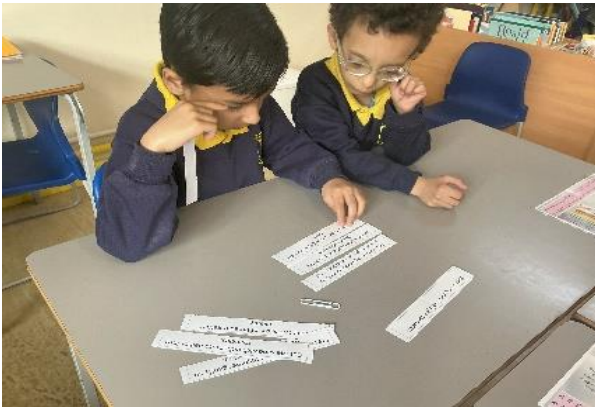


## Learning in Rowan Class
