Online Safety Tip of the Week

Online Safety Tip of the Week:

Remember the SMART Rules for Staying Safe Online

The **SMART rules** are a simple way to help children remember how to stay safe when using the internet, playing games or using apps.

S – Safe: Keep personal information such as your full name, address, school and passwords private.

M – Meet: Never arrange to meet someone you have only spoken to online without telling a trusted adult.

A – Accepting: Think carefully before accepting messages, files, links or friend requests from people you do not know.

R – Reliable: Remember that not everything you see or read online is true. Check information with a trusted adult or another reliable source.

T – Tell: Tell a trusted adult if anything online makes you feel worried, uncomfortable or unsure.

Parents and carers can support children by regularly talking about the SMART rules at home and reminding them that they should always speak to a trusted adult if something happens online that concerns them.

Stop, think and be SMART – simple rules can help children enjoy the online world safely and confidently.
